

Newsletter - Pitt Street Station

February 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

CPB Contractors (CPB) will deliver the new Sydney Metro Pitt Street Station in the Sydney CBD.

Pitt Street Station construction work

CPB site establishment, service investigation and installation work will continue throughout February.

From **Monday 1 February**, day and night work will continue for construction of the integrated station development.

February work will include:

- day work to excavate a crane base within the site compounds ahead of the delivery of cranes into the North and South sites in February and March
- scanning, surveying, saw cutting and potholing existing utility services and placing markings on the ground to identify underground services
- road and footpath trenching for the installation of power services to the site compounds
- delivery and installation of site hoarding and sheds, and placement of graphics and signage
- delivery of equipment and material to the sites
- temporary parking lane and short term lane closures around the work areas
- temporary partial pedestrian footpath closures with alternative routes provided.

Standard work hours

Standard work hours are **Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 1pm.**

Some work will be undertaken outside of standard construction hours.

Out of hours work

Due to high daytime traffic volumes and the need to ensure pedestrian safety, some of this work will need to be completed outside standard construction work hours. A community notification containing further details of work outside of standard construction hours will be delivered to properties ahead of the work along with email updates sent to the subscribed stakeholder distribution list.

What to expect

- Equipment used will include, but is not limited to, excavators, jackhammers, concrete saws, electric tools, power drills, cranes, lighting towers, vacuum trucks, electronic work platforms, light trucks, delivery trucks and traffic control.
- **Some of this work will be noisy.** The project team will take every step possible to minimise noise impacts. A range of mitigation measures are in place to meet the project's approval conditions and reduce noise such as using only the necessary equipment for each task, turning off equipment when not in use and equipping all machinery with non-tonal movement alarms.
- Temporary traffic and pedestrian changes may be required for large vehicle deliveries, including traffic control, for the safety of the community. Access to properties will be maintained at all times during the work.

Upcoming work and temporary traffic changes

Temporary weekend lane closures are being planned to allow for the delivery of two cranes into the North site compound from:


- **11pm Saturday 13 February to 12am on Monday 15 February** (25 hour duration) and
- **11pm Saturday 27 February to 12am on Monday 1 March** (25 hour duration).

This will involve temporary lane closures on Park Street between Pitt and Castlereagh streets. Two way traffic will be maintained on Park Street, one lane in each direction.

A community notification with detailed information on the confirmed date and times will be delivered to nearby properties a minimum of seven days prior the closure date and communicated through emails to members of the subscribed project stakeholder email distribution list.
